Competition format and equipment requirements

- One round of pools followed by DE to 10 hits for U11 and U13 or 15 hits for U15 age groups
- Weapon sizes: U11 + U13 must use size 3 foils or smaller, size 2 epee and sabre or smaller. U15 may use size 5 or smaller.
- Jackets, masks and breeches minimum 350N CE Level 1
- Under plastrons 350N for U11 + U13, 800N for U15 age groups
- Sabre gloves 800N
- Conductive bibs required for U15 foil only
- Weight and gauge testing will take place. Failures in equipment will be carded

Prizes and Medals

Medals will be awarded for the top 4 places in each event. If you won a trophy last year, please don't forget to have it engraved and returned in time for this year's event.

There may also be awards for technical merit. These will be awarded to the fencer who, in the opinion of the judges, demonstrates the best technique.

EYC results may also be used for direct selection to England Fencing Squads taken to foreign competitions. Criteria vary by year and by weapon – please see the England Fencing website for current information.
