



British Fencing Level 1 & 2 Referee & Entry Level Armoury Training

Sabre Refereeing: Friday 16th March, 8:00 am – 11:00 am

Epee Refereeing: Friday 16th March, 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm

Armoury: Saturday 17th March 2012, 11.00 am – 4.00 pm

Foil Refereeing: Saturday 17th March, 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm

As part of the National Academy programme, British Fencing are running training courses in all areas of fencing officiating.

The level 1 & 2 refereeing qualifications consist of two examinations: theory (written) and practical (observation of refereeing).

The first hour of each course is scheduled for the written examination. The actual courses will start one hour after the advertised start time. Candidates may arrange to sit the written exam at another time should contact Jack Boteler.

It may be possible for some candidates to referee at the Championships and undertake their practical examination. Candidates wishing to do so should also contact Jack Boteler.

A basic knowledge of armoury is essential for all fencers as it enables you to maintain your kit. Have you ever been convinced that you've scored a valid hit, only to find that no light has appeared on the box, or have you ever found that a white light has come on while you are fencing for no apparent reasons? The armoury course will teach you how to solve such problems, helping you to be more successful as a competitive fencer and saving you money by showing you how to fix your kit instead of buying unnecessary replacements!

Priority for all courses will be given on a first come, first served basis.

The courses will be run at **EIS Sheffield, Coleridge Road, Sheffield, South Yorkshire, S9 5DA**

There will be no refreshments provided although there is a café on site.

Referee course tutors TBC. Armoury course tutors Andrew Goodier & Steve Jackson.

Cost: £20 per course, £30 for two, £45 for 3, £50 for all 4.

This fee can be refunded by volunteering at British Fencing events, at a rate of £10/event.
