ASSISTANCE WITH MAJOR CHAMPIONSHIP COSTS FOR YOUTH* FENCERS

In the event that financial circumstances might prevent a youth* fencer attending a major Championship, British Fencing, through various funds, may be able to assist with some or even all costs.

Applications should be made in writing to Piers Martin, CEO, c/o headoffice@britishfencing.com.

Applicants should outline their financial circumstances and reasons for support. In general, awards would not be made to fencers who have been able to fund the presence of parents or personal coaches at international qualifying events as these grants will be for fencers who might not otherwise be able to represent Great Britain.

However, each case will be scrutinised on its own individual merits and further supporting information may be requested by British Fencing.

Applications for support should be made within 1 calendar week of the team being posted on British Fencing's website.

There are no appeals to decisions taken by British Fencing.

Falsification of information may lead to withdrawal of funds, removal of ranking points, disqualification from the team or disciplinary action and recovery of any funds already disbursed.
