Notes

- These Championships are open to all members of British Fencing who are British Citizens and satisfy the following age restrictions:
 - Juniors – under 20 and over 13 on 1st January 2011, i.e. born between 1/1991 and 12/1997 inc.
 - Cadets – under 17 on 1st January 2011, i.e. born 1/1994 or later.
- Only one event may be entered each day.
- Providing they meet the age requirements above there is no restriction on Cadets entering the Junior Championships.
- Gala finals will be at approximately 17.00 each day.
- Medals, certificates and prizes will be awarded to the top four in each event.
- All fencers and spectators participate at their own risk, and are personally responsible for their own safety. Spectators are admitted to the venue, and entries accepted, on the understanding that British Fencing, the organising committee, officials, referees and staff of EIS Sheffield cannot accept responsibility for accidents, loss or damage to persons or property, however caused.
