

NOTES TO ACCOMPANY THE BRITISH FENCING OLYMPIC SELECTION POLICY

The Board of British Fencing have agreed the following:

1. No change to the Olympic Selection Policy. This includes the date.
2. The Policy is for the names of athletes who will be “selected” for nomination to the BOA. The BOA selects Team GB.
3. The “Olympic Selectors” (Section 14) must be appointed by the Board and must be free of conflicts and bias.
4. The Chair must be independent and is non-voting, responsible for managing the meetings and discussions.
5. The Board will appoint a Chair from Sports Resolution along with a panel of three people, appointed from outside of the sport and therefore with no possible conflict or bias. This panel to be appointed from people who understand performance selection processes in sport.
6. The Chair, CEO and with the International Portfolio Director will identify possible candidates for approval by the Board at the first meeting in 2012.
7. The Board will use all 8 Host Nation Places, in line with the Olympic Selection Policy and BF objectives (sections 1 and 15). This means that athletes will be selected for nomination who are potential medallists in 2012 or in 2016.
8. The Performance Manager will be advised by the experts on the Performance Team and the Performance Advisory Group.
