PISTE ASSISTANT AWARD TUTOR

This is an exciting opportunity to be a part of the fencing Young Officials Project. The project is a partnership between the Youth Sport Trust and British Fencing to increase the number of people officiating within fencing. The project aims to qualify 100+ young people (14-25) in fencing officiating before the Sainsbury's UK School Games in Sheffield, September 2011.

We are looking for tutors to play an important part in this project by delivering training to young people through the Piste Assistant Award. The award is a perfect introduction for young people looking to take their first steps in officiating and is designed for fencers and non-fencers alike aged 14+.

The award encompasses:

- Time Keeping
- Scoring
- Pool Sheets
- Referee Assistance

As a tutor you will receive:

- £50 payment for successful delivery of a course
- Student resource packs

In return you will provide an exciting and informative training course to young people. The exact structure of the course you deliver is flexible dependent on the course attendees.

Those who have attended a course will be expected to be competent to time keep, score, fill out pool sheets and provide general referee assistance within a fencing competition environment. Payment for the course will be dependent on the return of attendees' registration and monitoring forms to demonstrate the attendance of 10+ young people aged 14-19; others outside this age range may also attend the course.
