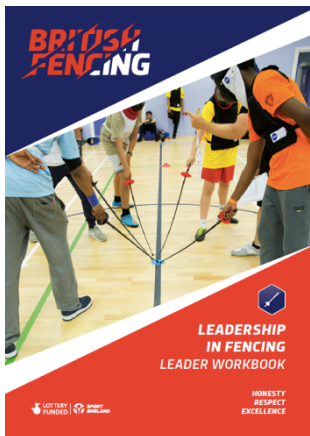


Aims of the Award

The course has been designed to develop young peoples leadership skills, using fencing as the vehicle to achieve this. The course structure is modular with a flexible delivery model to adjust to the needs of those young leaders involved. By the end of the course the Explorers should:

- Be aware of their leadership skills and abilities
- Be able to continue developing their leadership skills using fencing based activities
- Be able to raise the profile of fencing within a young leadership role at their organisation
- Be able to inspire other become actively involved with fencing



Leadership in Fencing Course Information

- Explorers (young people aged 14+)
- Explorers who want to improve their leadership skills and play an active role in supporting the delivery of fencing with Scouts and Cubs

Course Structure

- 6 hours - British Fencing can provide a Coach Developer to deliver the course, or we can train Adult Leaders who want to deliver the course themselves as part of the Explorer programme. This enables delivery to take place in bite size chunks eg, 2x3 or 3x2 hours sessions
- Maximum of up to 12 candidates

Cost

- 1 day Course delivered by British Fencing:
 - £30pp which includes all resources and the Cost of of the Coach Developer
- If delivering the course yourself (following the completion of training), the cost is £15pp and includes:
 - Course resources
 - Certificate of attendance
 - Free set of 12 Bronze Awards and Certificates to award to Scouts and Cubs (covered in training)
