

BRITISH FENCING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019 - Individual Events

Entry information

Date: Saturday 13th & Sunday 14th April 2019

Venue: SportsDock, University of East London, Docklands Campus, E16 2RD

Eligibility The Senior British Championships are open only to individuals of British Nationality. This includes individuals with multiple nationalities, provided the fencer does not hold an FIE license issued for a country other than Great Britain. The competition is open to any fencer who is at least 13 on the day of the event. Individual British Fencing membership is compulsory and will be required to submit the online entry.

No fencer can enter more than one individual event per day.

Any athlete wishing to be selected for Great Britain at FIE (including Satellites) or EFC competitions must compete in the National Championships in the relevant category - Cadet, Junior or Senior. Only in exceptional circumstances will an exemption be granted, which must be sought in advance and received in the form of written approval via British Fencing Head Office.

Format 1 Round of poules with a cut of 10-20% depending on numbers followed by Direct Elimination to Gala Final.

Note: There may be a gap following the completion of the quarter final matches because of the live streaming schedule start times.
