1. FORMAT

1.1 TEAM FORMAT

- All Teams are to be made up of 3 Fencers plus one reserve
- Matches will be fenced using the relay system of 45 hits
- U11's fence 2-minute fights, all other age groups 3-minute fights
- Fencers may be allowed to fence up **one** age group – this must be confirmed by British Fencing before the event- please email eventsadmin@britishfencing.com to confirm
- Fencers may only enter one team within each weapon event, they may be named as a reserve for another team for the same school until he/she has actually fenced for either team- once this has occurred, they may only fence for this team
- Fencers may only enter **ONE** weapon and event **Per Day**
- Schools may enter up to 2 teams in the same event.
- **Incomplete teams will not be allowed to compete**

1.2 AGE GROUPS

Please note, the school year age groups listed below are as a guide. It is the fencers own date of birth which decided their age group. Dates of Birth should be checked carefully by teachers, as pupils may not be in their “correct” school year.

U11 Born 01/09/2008 – 31/08/2011 (school years 4-6)

U13 Born 01/09/2006 – 31/08/2008 (school years 7-8)

U15 Born 01/09/2004 – 31/08/2006 (school years 9-10)

U18 Born 01/09/2001 – 31/08/2004 (school years 11-13)

1.4 COMPETITION FORMAT

Check in times and start times for each event may vary depending on entry numbers and scheduling. Check in times will be sent to each participating school after the entry closing date. Please ensure the best email address for contact is listed via Sport80 when entering the competition, as email communication will be sent via Sport80.

2. ENTRIES

2.1 ENTERING TEAMS

Entry Fee is £70 per team. The closing date for entries is **Friday 14th February 2020 at 23:55**.

All fencers entered must hold an individual compete BF membership.

All entries are to be submitted through the BF Sport80 Platform (www.bf.sport80.com). One Coach/Teacher/Representative for each school is able to register for an account.

Entry fees can also be paid via bank transfer (by selecting invoice payment option on Sport80).

Any school who may have financial difficulties, and feel the entry fee may be a barrier to participating, please contact eventsadmin@britishfencing.com who can put you in touch with the British Fencing charity, who may be able to assist in funding.

British School Team Championships 2020 Entry Information

Please follow the format below for all entries:

Age group, Gender, Weapon, School (and A/B or similar if entering 2 teams)

e.g. U11 Girls Epee British Fencing A or U11 Girls Epee British Fencing

Coaches/Teachers/Representatives who are registering the teams must ensure that all the information required is provided and is correct for every fencer. This includes the **BF membership number** of all fencers and **date of birth**.

3. KIT SPECIFICATIONS

- All fencers must wear the correct kit including breeches, long socks, plastrons and masks with back straps.
- Girls of all ages must wear chest protectors
- U11 and U13 Fencers must use size 2 epees and sabres and size 3 foils or smaller
- Conductive bibs for foil will be required for under 15 and under 18 sabre events
- 800N plastrons will be required for under 15 and under 18 age groups

4. REFEREES

Schools entering 2 or more teams into the competition (per day) **MUST** provide a referee. This is to ensure the smooth running of the competition with a sufficient number of referees.

If a school does not feel that they will be able to provide a referee, please contact eventsadmin@britishfencing.com as soon as possible before the closing date.

If schools do not make contact with BF or provide a named referee before **14th February 2020** they will not be allowed to fence at the competition.
