


- Activity Finder

 - Information can be updated under the 'Marketing Information' tab in the club membership window on sport80



Club Transfers

We have activated a new feature within sport80 that allows members to move clubs via a transfer system. This means that clubs can now track members affiliations and gain a better understanding of their club

Members can request transfers via their own membership profile, these would then need to be approved by both clubs to be actioned

Clubs also have a 'Block' feature which can be used to prevent member from affiliating with their club

All features can be found in the left-hand menu on the club profile on sport80
